The children in our special class will commence their schooling in Junior Infants.</p> <p>7.1.2.2: If the child is currently enrolled in our mainstream setting with a diagnosis of ASD and a recommendation for a special needs class.</p> <p>7.1.2.3: If the child has siblings currently attending Scoil Choilm CNS (including stepsiblings, resident at the same address if they meet the criteria in relation to age and ability to integrate into mainstream).</p> <p>7.1.2.4: If the child resides in the catchment area. The catchment area, for enrolment purposes is in the Dublin 15 area and is outlined in Appendix 1.</p>
